CLASS DESCRIPTION

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials.

All dogs competing in Agility will be required to present an official AKC Jump Height Card prior to running in an Agility Trial. All dogs **except those jumping 24" and 26" (unless a VMO or AKC Rep is present)** without permanent or temporary height cards will be measured. **If you have a height card, please submit a copy with your entry. SHOW ME AGILITY CLUB WILL ACCEPT PHOTOCOPIES OF THE PERMANENT OR UNEXPIRED TEMPORARY HEIGHT CARD WITH THE ENTRY FOR THIS SHOW.**

OBSTACLES

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current list of Mandatory Obstacles. Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Breeds not registerable with the AKC are eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

There will be NO contact obstacle familiarization for Novice dogs. (Per AKC Rules September 1, 2006)

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial giving club and it's Trial Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter postmarked before June 23, 2008.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Show Me Agility Club of Central Missouri has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on entries.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks will be charged a \$25 fee.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Show Me Agility Club of Central Missouri does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

## DIRECTIONS

**FROM WEST.** Take I-70 to the I-63 exit (#128A). Turn South on Hwy 63, then left at the first light (get in the leftmost right turn lane on the exit ramp, which is I-70 drive S.E. CCSC is 1.3 miles on the right. **FROM EAST,** take I-70 to the Lake of the Woods exit. Turn Left (South) over I-70 then immediately Right on the access Road (before the gas station, do not go to the light, I-70 Drive S.W. CCSC is 1 mile on your left. **FROM NORTH OR SOUTH:** Take Highway 63 to I-70 Dr.S.E. Turn east; CCSC is 1.3 miles on right.
